Math and Language Arts Summer Institute

The focus of this program is to get students who are below grade level in reading, writing, or math skills ready to enter high school and be successful in their 9th grade Algebra 1 and English classes. *If a student has already taken and passed Algebra 1, this program is not for them.* Students will earn 10 elective credits (5 English, 5 Math) when completing the Institute. Free busing will be provided from some middle schools to the designated high school (see front cover).

Mathematics

- Students will learn strategies that will help them become better problem solvers as well as revisit previous content in order to build a solid foundation of the skills necessary for success in Algebra 1.
- Students will review and practice 6th and 7th grade standards as listed on the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) to prepare them for success in passing the CAHSEE.

Language Arts

- Students will learn useful reading skills to help them to be successful in core content classes, to improve their test-taking skills, and to help them pass the CASHEE.
- Students will practice writing and editing skills that will help them become better writers, and therefore, better prepared for success in their core content classes and for success in passing the CAHSEE.
