East Side Union High School District is requesting a proposal, for the Districtwide Fire Alarm Modernization Project (DWFA), from the District's pre-qualified Division of State Architect (DSA) Project Inspection firms/Inspectors of Record (IOR) to provide DSA-required, professional DSA Project Inspector (PI) IOR services, for the scope of work as listed in this RFP, including all DSA-required documentation and submittals.

Class 2 Inspectors are anticipated for this Project. The Inspector who is selected for this project must be certified and/or approved by DSA prior to the start of construction, and must possess the required DSA Inspector Classification.

- Respondent should review construction documents for complete scope of work. Generally, the Project consists of the following:
 - As part of the Districtwide Fire Alarm (DWFA) Modernization Project replacement, in whole or in part, of the fire alarm systems is being performed at sixteen sites district wide, to support the demands of the modernization program, code requirements, as well as to mitigate the increasing annual repair and maintenance costs of the existing systems. Every ESUHSD site is planned to receive improvements

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through this project (13 High School campuses; 2 Adult Education Centers; 1 District Office). Improvements include replacement of the existing, obsolete fire alarm control units with new, district standard Gamewell FCI E3 control units at all sites that are not currently using E3 controls units as well as replacement of obsolete and incompatible fire detection devices and alarm notification appliances in selected buildings at several sites. See attached Volume 2 RFP Criteria Document for details regarding the Fire Alarm Modernization work at each site.

- The Criteria Document and Schematic Drawings, Design Drawings or Construction Drawings provided as part of this RFP shows the buildings at each site where Fire Alarm Modernization work will be performed. Ten (10) sites Andrew Hill, Ed. Center, Foothill, Independence, Independence Adult Ed., James Lick, Mt. Pleasant, Piedmont Hills, Silver Creek, Yerba Buena shall receive comprehensive modernization, including replacement to District standard Control Units and replacement of obsolete and incompatible fire detection devices and alarm notification appliances in selected buildings. Six (6) Calero, Evergreen, W.C. Overfelt, Overfelt Adult Center, Oak Gove, Santa Teresa sites shall receive limited modernization, such as replacement of obsolete or incompatible Fire Alarm Control Units or modernize radio transmitters.

 Substantial portion of the construction work, including Fire Alarm system and devices installation and testing, will be performed between 3:00 pm and 11:00 pm by the contractor to minimize impact to the functioning school campuses.

IOR Services Required and Professional Inspection Services Agreement

- Limited IOR observation, inspections and coordination, related to the installation of Fire Alarm System and devices will be required. Full time IOR is not anticipated, subject to DSA requirements.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to schedule general IOR inspections and observations between 3:00 pm and 5:00 pm.
- Final device testing observation by IOR is anticipated to occur between 3:00 pm and 11:00 pm.
 - Each of the ten (10) sites receiving comprehensive modernization, are expected to require five days each between 3:00 pm and 11:00 pm for IOR observation of final device testing.
 - Each of the six (6) sites receiving limited modernization, are expected to require two days each between 3:00 pm and 11:00 pm for IOR observation of final device testing
- Pursuant to Pre-Application meeting with DSA, the review of the DW Fire Alarm documents will be for Fire-Life Safety only. Structural or accessibility review is not expected to be a component to this project. The District will be engaging through a separate contract, geotechnical services firm for providing limited geotechnical observations during the project.
- Subject to the schedule and phasing information provided in this RFP, the IOR/Project Inspector shall provide adequate manpower through the course of this project, adequate number of inspectors, one or more as required to comply with DSA requirements.
- IOR services include reviewing of contract documents, attending meetings, and inspection of work and materials for compliance with contract documents, codes and standards.

- The selected IOR firm or entity will be required to execute the Professional Inspection Services Agreement and the Conflict of Interest Statement, copies attached
- Minimum IOR Services required are delineated on the District's Professional Inspection Services Agreement, which is included as attachment to this document.

 - o Prior experience and past project successes in projects similar to DWFA (10%)
 - o Adequate staffing commitment and schedule commitment (20%).

- The District reserves the option to reject any or all proposals, wholly or in part, received by reason of this request.
- All proposals shall remain firm for forty-five (45) days following the closing date for receipt of proposals.
- The District reserves the right to award the contract to the Inspector who presents the proposal which in the judgment of the District, best accomplishes the desired results.
