The geotechnical observations and reports shall be for the District's quality assurance purposes, as DSA mandated geotechnical inspections or reports are not anticipated on this project since the scope of work is predominantly Fire Alarm Systems modernization. Nevertheless the geotechnical consultant must possess required DSA certification, classification or approval, as applicable.

- Respondent should review construction documents for complete scope of work. Generally, the Project consists of the following:
 - As part of the Districtwide Fire Alarm (DWFA) Modernization Project replacement, in whole or in part, of the fire alarm systems is being performed at sixteen sites district wide, to support the demands of the modernization program, code requirements, as well as to mitigate the increasing annual repair and maintenance costs of the existing systems. Every ESUHSD site is planned to receive improvements through this project (13 High School campuses; 2 Adult Education Centers; 1 District Office). Improvements include replacement of the existing, obsolete fire alarm control units with new, district standard Gamewell FCI E3 control units at all sites that are not currently using E3 controls units as well as replacement of obsolete and incompatible fire detection devices and alarm notification appliances in selected buildings at several sites.  - The project sites at addresses listed above will require trenching and backfill for installation of new conduits and cabling. Anticipated location and length of new trenches at these sites are identified in the attached Schematic Drawings; a few locations remain to be determined subject to the design process.

Geotechnical Observations and Contract Services Agreement

- Limited geotechnical observations and monitoring during trenching and backfill compaction work, approx.. 2000LF of trenching at 50 locations, at the sites listed above will be required. Services shall include attendance at meetings as necessary, document review, and final reports for the District's records.
- Anticipate compaction testing for 3 trenching location for each site and two soil sampling for each site.
- DSA mandated observations, inspections, testing, and reporting is not anticipated on this project.
- The selected geotechnical consulting firm or entity will be required to execute the Contract Services Agreement and the Conflict of Interest Statement, sample copies attached.
