



BVAL SPECTATOR POLICY ANNOUNCEMENT

March 12, 2021

At the March 12, 2021 Board of Managers' meeting, the BVAL principals reviewed and approved a modified spectator policy for all BVAL athletic events for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. Brief details of the policy are listed below:

THIS SPECTATOR POLICY GOES INTO EFFECT ON MONDAY, MARCH 15TH, 2021.

- Based on CDPH guidelines and county approval, Blossom Valley Athletic League (BVAL) member schools will allow immediate household members, determined by the maximum number allowed per sport in the chart below and based on individual school's facility specifications, to attend athletic events for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. Spectators must follow the host school's protocols for entry into the contest. Spectators are limited to ensure physical distance can be maintained, reduce potential crowding, and maintain indoor and outdoor capacity limits.
- If a spectator is asked to leave a BVAL contest due to poor sportsmanship, not adhering to CDPH guidelines, and/or not adhering to host school guidelines, that spectator will not be allowed to attend BVAL contests for the remainder of the 2021 season.
- All spectators will be required to present their student-athlete's name at the entrance for verification from a player roster. ALL FAMILY MEMBERS are requested to enter at the same time to avoid confusion. We ask for patience, as this process will take some time for our schools' event staffs to complete. Please plan accordingly. For more information, please contact your school's athletic director.
