

Design Standard Flagpoles

Purpose

The purpose of this design standard is to ensure consistency in the provision of flagpoles at each campus, which are functionally and aesthetically appropriate to each school's environment.

Design Standard

1. General:
 - a. Site flagpole(s) near Administration building, to provide intuitive way finding. This allows visitors to find the main office "near the flagpole".
2. Specifics:
 - a. Flagpoles shall be aluminum, unpainted.
 - b. Flagpole heights shall be appropriate to the site, generally 30'
 - c. Flagpoles shall have a round gold finial at the top.
 - d. Flagpoles shall have light fixtures at the base, for nighttime illumination. This ensures that the flags can be displayed at night, negating the need for staff to raise and lower the flags on a daily basis. The light fixture shall be controlled automatically, to negate the need for human intervention and error.
 - e. Flags shall be weatherproof material, appropriate for 24/7/365 exposure.
 - f. Comply with rules for use and display of the flag (36 United States Code 173-178)
