

FINANCES

The East Side Union High School District has maintained a very solvent budget. The district's reserve exceeds the state requirement. Most of the funding the district receives is generated primarily by the average daily attendance of the students. Over 68.1% of East Side's budget is a result of actual student attendance. In addition, the district receives 18% of state revenue for special purposes such as: Special Education, Voluntary Integration Program, Child Nutrition and Adult Education. Local revenue of 7.6% is generated by interest and fees. Only 2% of the budget comes from State lottery funds and another 4.3% is received from federal programs.
