The capstone course offers students the opportunity to develop business plan and operate a student run business.

Whether you plan on pursuing an advanced degree or entering the workplace after school graduation, this pathway gives you the leadership training and technical skills needed to succeed in business today.

By the end of the program, you'll be able to successfully:

- Design graphic presentations and web pages following rules of design

- Create web pages in HTML with CSS
- Write simple scripts to create form validation, slide shows, etc
- Become MOS Certified (Microsoft Office Specialist)
- Know the foundational skills needed to start your own business
