Activity

The committee was asked to introduce themselves and find a noon partner, three o'clock partner, six o'clock partner and a nine o'clock partner. Participants were asked to find their 3 o'clock partners. Part of the task was to look at the Mission. The task was to think of what our schools should look like. The group proposed, "To

Educate Students and Prepare them for the Mission in a Safe and Engaging Environment, In Partnership with Families and Communities.”

They were then asked to team up with their six o'clock partners and think about the Vision.

They were then asked to team up with their nine o'clock partners and think about the Core Values: respect, value of diversity, equity, open communication, commitment to excellence, professional development, and responsibility. Ms. Grey asked the participants to evaluate all of our East Side stakeholders' when reviewing our Core Values, as if they breathe and lived them, and how would it look.

All the notes taken tonight will be typed disaggregated, prioritized and categorized.

Participants were asked to review Vision statements, Mission statements, and Goals statements. They were also asked to look at what others in the groups had written.

Participants then met with their noon partners and asked to think of their high school experience; things they loved, and of things that were not so wonderful. We will start looking at what our high schools should look like.
