## • 2004-05 Reassignment (Estimated Savings): \$600,000

#### Plan

- 12 Teachers on Special and Comp. Ed. Assignments Back to the Classroom
- 3 Classified Managers Reduction to Support Comp. Ed. Schools Legal Compliance
- 12 Teachers @ \$85,000 = \$1,020,000 (half year)
- 3 Managers @\$60,000 = \$180,0000 (half year)

#### • Reduce Library Services by 50% (Estimated Savings): \$255,000

Reduce all ESUHSD General fund Budgets by 20% Priority reductions to include Classified and Certificated Managers

## • Deferred Maintenance Credit Based on Legal Opinion \$5,200,000
