Services"

Background

The Instructional Services division began the process of seeking input from Stakeholder groups regarding options for those ESUHSD seniors who have met all graduation requirements except passing the California High School Exit Exam.

The issue of not passing the Exit Exam raises concerns regarding participation in the graduation ceremony and receiving a Certificate of Completion or similar document that acknowledges all graduation requirements have been met except for the California High School Exit Exam.

Representatives of the ESUHSD, including administrators, classified and certificated personnel attended a Santa Clara County Office of Education sponsored forum on the ramifications of the California High School Exit Exam on February 7, 2006. District representatives joined attorneys and personnel from ACSA and CSBA in discussions regarding the differences between the high school diploma and a certificate of completion.

The ESUHSD stakeholder representatives reconvened after the forum to discuss and consider the information gathered in order to make a district level recommendation. After the first meeting, a sub committee was formed and possible options were formulated and brought back to the entire group. Input was also sought from parents and students.

At a subsequent meeting, consensus was reached on the following items:

 An ESUHSD non-graduate is a student who does not meet the 220 credit requirement and/or has not passed the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE). • ESUHSD non-graduates will be given an individualized plan indicating what they have achieved and the items needed to earn a diploma. A district-wide form will be created for this plan.

Furthermore, after much discussion, the stakeholder group could not reach consensus on the participation of students who have passed all of the district's course requirements by the end of the senior year but are unable to pass the high school exit examination attending the graduation ceremony and graduation activities. The stakeholder group suggested this decision be made by the Superintendent and Executive Cabinet.

Recommendations

The Superintendent and the Executive Cabinet are recommending that students who have earned 220 credits and have not yet passed the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) participate in the graduation ceremony/activities and that they receive an individualized plan and certificate of completion.
