Governor's Wife to Visit Silver Creek High School

On Friday, October 27, 2000, at 1:45 p.m. at Silver Creek High School, 3434 Silver Creek Road, San Jose, First Lady, **Sharon Davis**, will be providing a legislative update to Silver Creek seniors.

Mrs. Davis will be addressing several hundred students and staff members. Her visit is part of her commitment to education. She believes that education is the key to a brighter future for all students.

Part of her message will focus on the expansion of the Cal Grants Program and the opportunities it provides. Under the Cal Grant expansion bill, Cal Grant A scholarships will be awarded to financially eligible students with a B (3.0) grade average to use at public or private four year universities and Cal Grant B scholarships will go to students with a C (2.0) grade average to be used at a community college. Mrs. Davis will also stress to the students the importance of giving back to the community.

Principal **Fred deFuniak** was pleased that the First Lady selected Silver Creek. "We appreciate **Mrs. Davis'** visit. It is a great opportunity for our students and staff to hear first hand about the Governor's new initiatives and to be able to interact with the First Lady."
