Independence High School Wins Golden Bell Award

The Space, Science & Technology Magnet Program at Independence High School was selected to receive a Golden Bell Award by the California School Boards Association (CSBA).

The CSBA Golden Bell Awards Program promotes excellence in education by recognizing outstanding programs in school districts and county offices of education throughout California. Although many programs are considered, only the best are selected for this prestigious award. The goal of the awards program is to contribute to the development and evaluation of curriculum, instruction and support services.

The Space, Science & Technology Magnet Program integrates mathematics, science and technology classes and emphasizes team and project work.
