## East Side Union High School District Appoints New Director of Career Services and Two New Associate Principals

#### **Director of Career Services**

**Dr.** Geraldine Forté, current Principal at Oak Grove High School, will now take the lead as the district's Director of Career Services. **Dr.** Forté has served as an administrator in the district for over a year. She has been in administration at Santa Clara, Milpitas, and Fremont Unified School Districts for over eleven years. **Dr.** Forté has served as a high school principal, assistant principal, and a middle school assistant principal. **Dr.** Forté earned her doctorate from University of San Francisco in 1993. She earned her bachelor's and master's degree from San Jose State University. We will be seeking a replacement for **Dr.** Forté presently.

#### Associate Principal at Andrew P. Hill High School

Marla Valladárez Bressani, current Advisor at Independence High School, will now join the administrative team at Andrew P. Hill High School as the Associate Principal of Administrative Services. Ms. Bressani has been assisting the Associate Principal of Administrative Services at Independence for the last two years and has worked alongside police and probation officers on campus, as well as with community liaisons. Ms. Bressani was also a Spanish and sheltered English teacher at Yerba Buena High School teaching English to sheltered students. Ms. Bressani has a bachelor's degree in Spanish with an English minor and master's degree in Education from San Jose State University.

#### Associate Principal at Mt. Pleasant High School

Marlow M. Viehweg comes to the district from Utah and brings to East Side Union High School District over 20 years of administrative experience.

Mr. Viehweg has served as a Vocational Director, Community School Director, Alternative High School Assistant Principal and High School Principal. During his tenure as a high school principal, the drop-out rate decreased by 50%, vandalism decreased, and the number of students continuing their education after high school graduation increased. Mr. Viehweg taught high risk students in an alternative setting for four years. Mr. Viehweg has both a Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees in Business Administration and Business Education from Utah State University in Logan, Utah.
