At the **Board Meeting of April 6, 2006** the members of the public were given an opportunity to address the Board. Some items of discussion were:

★ **Academic Achievement**

- *Oak Grove High School* administration and a student presented student achievement data. It was noted that *Oak Grove* received a WASC six-year accreditation with a three-year revisit.
- The *Board* approved a salary increase of COLA minus 2%, which equates to 3.58%, for all confidentials, classified managers and administrators, effective the 2005/2006 school year.

★ **Recommendation re: Evergreen/East Hills Vision Strategy and District's Short-Term and Long-Term Facilities Needs and Planning**

- *The Evergreen/East Hills Vision Strategy* is a comprehensive land use and transportation planning effort that is expected to guide residential development in *Evergreen and East Hills* in the future. The *Board* approved the *Administration recommendation as amended*, with one member (*Patricia Martinez-Roach*) voting no and another member (*George Shirakawa*) recusing himself from all discussion and voting. The amendments as approved include: (i) *District shall seek allocation of funds to assist the District in passage of a future bond measure for construction of a new school when such need arises, and* (ii) *District shall seek and be entitled to direct input in the development of the new Evergreen Development Policy in regard to matters that will affect or contribute to the acquisition of lands or raising of funds to meet the needs of the District.*
