At the **Board Meeting of May 11, 2006**, the Board acted on the following items:

★ **Charter School Renewal for MACSA Academia Calmecac**

The Board approved a five year renewal of the *MACSA Academia Calmecac Charter School* contract. An annual report and review will be required by the *Charter school*.

★ **Local School Wellness Policy - First Reading**

★ **Adopt Resolution #2005/2006 - 36 - re: Opposition to HR4437**

The Board approved to oppose *HR4437 "Border Protection, Antiterrorism and Illegal Immigration Control Act"* that if passed into law would hinder the education of all children in the community and disrupt the lives of families in our communities and students' education by threatening to separate families.

★ **California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) Waivers for Special Education Students**

The Board approved the *CAHSEE* waivers for special education students. *Education Code section 60851* states that students who take one or both parts of the *CAHSEE* with a modification and receive the equivalent of a passing score are eligible for the waiver request process.
