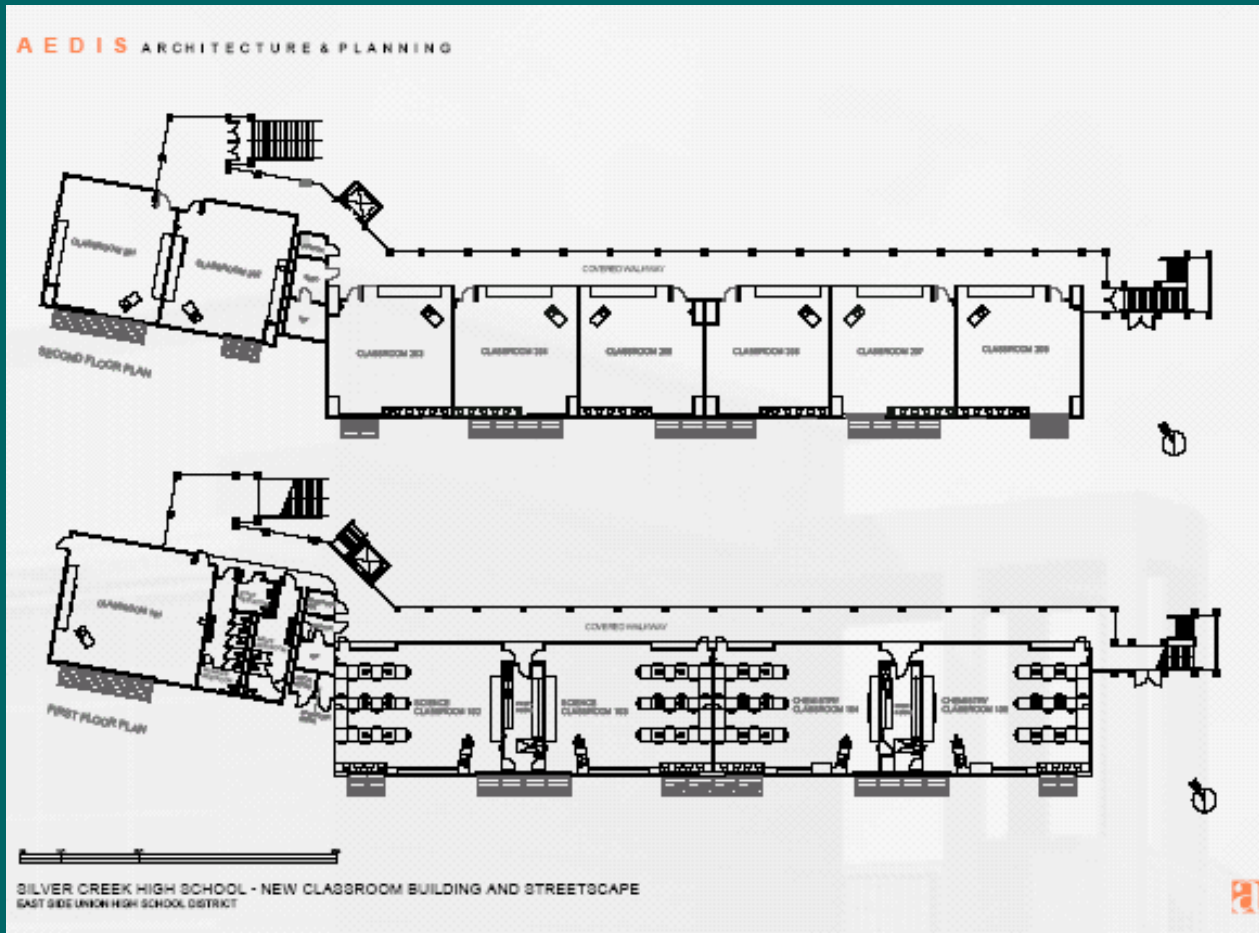

Priorities;

1. Create and upgrade Science Labs in building E-1 – E-4.
 - a. Counters
 - b. Shelves
2. Upgrade school "G" building
 - a. Add stall in boys restroom.
 - b. Upgrade room G-1 to school district safety standards suitable from teaching.
3. Family Learning Center
 - a. Expand play area out to grassy area.
 - b. Room 3
 - a. Knock down diaper changing area.
 - b. Remove washer & dryer to outside area.
 - c. Eliminate walls in diaper changing area.
4. Upgrade custodial facility.
 - a. Room to park district vehicle.
 - b. Create small office.
5. Upgrade campus facilities.
 - a. Repair classroom windows.
 - b. Classroom Doors.
 - c. Repair facility sidings and painting especially in "G" building.
 - d. Classroom ceilings (Library, Hooper Hall)
 - e. Classroom light fixtures (B-3)
6. Create more parking spaces.
 - a. Utilizing half of basketball court.
7. Additional funds allocated to improving school's:
 - a. P.A. System.
 - b. Upgrade computer lab.
 - c. Computer LCD projectors for media presentations.
 - d. Library theft mechanism (doorway), dummy cameras.
