East Side Union High School District Seeks Applicants for the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee

The East Side Union High School District is recruiting applicants to serve on the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC).

Measures G, E, I, and Technology I were passed under the rules of Proposition 39, which directs the Board of Trustees to appoint a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to monitor bond expenditures. This Committee is responsible for reviewing expenditures related to the four general obligation bonds passed by voters: Measure G (\$298 million) approved by voters in March 2002; Measure E (\$349 million) approved by the voters in February 2008; Measure I (\$120 million) approved by the voters in November 2012; and Technology Measure I (\$113.2 million) approved by voters in November 2014.

The current CBOC has 13 members. Members serve two-year terms. The terms of 7 of the members will expire on May 31, 2015. All of the members whose terms are expiring are eligible to reapply.

No employee or official of the District can be appointed to the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee. Also vendors, contractors, or consultants of the district are not allowed to serve as members of the Committee.
