### **ESUHSD Student Invited to the White House**

**San Jose, CA** - - Anton Cao, an 11th grade student at Evergreen Valley High School, part of the East Side Union High School District, has been invited to attend the 2016 White House Science Fair being held tomorrow, April 13, in the White House East Room. Cao earned a perfect score on the AP Calculus AB Exam in Spring 2015 and was **1 of only 12 students in the world** to earn every point possible on the exam. Looking across approximately 4.5 million AP Exams taken by 2.5 million U.S. public high school students in 2015, only 322 students earned every point possible on an AP exam, a rare accomplishment.

President Obama will host the 6th and final White House Science Fair of his Administration, celebrating students in a board range of STEM fields. As an honored guest, Cao will hear remarks from the President, and interact with other students, professional scientists, high-level senior government officials, private sector representatives, and others.

The President will also announce new commitments in support of the Administration's "Computer Science for All" initiative announced earlier this year, as well as the "Educate to Innovate" campaign to ensure that all students are engaged and prepared in STEM subjects.
