- 87% pass rate for ELA CAHSEE
- 87% pass rate for MATH CAHSEE
- 34 of 58 Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- 15 of 58 Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 42 of 58 students currently have earned 100% of credits attempted "on track"
