**Goal 1:** The district will provide high quality instruction and learning opportunities preparing every student to graduate ready for college and career.

**Targets:**

- African American Grad Rate 83%
- African American Reduction Drop-Out Target 11%
- African American A-G Completion Rate 32%

**Actions/Services:**

- Instructional Coaches - 9 Coaches – 98% Approval Rating
- Comprehensive Assessment System – Purchased Illuminate – Data Warehouse
- Develop 21<sup>st</sup> Century Rubrics to Measure 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills 5Cs
- Provide A-G Credit Recovery – Summer & Cyber High
- Additional Librarian Hours
- Restore Class Size by 2

**Goal 2:** Establish healthy school culture to address the disengagement of students that lead to students dropping out and not graduating.

**Targets:**

- African American Grad Rate 83%
- African American Reduction Drop-Out Target 11%
- African American A-G Completion Rate 32%

**Actions/Services:**

- Monitoring the Progress of Students – Guidance Plan
- Implement Project Word to Help Support African American Students
- Decrease Suspensions – PBIS
- Social Workers –Social & Emotional Support
- District will Hire a Coordinator of Student Services
- Parent & Community Involvement Specialist

**Goal 3:** The district will develop and implement a strong guidance program to help students meet the graduation and A-G requirements

**Targets:**

- African American Grad Rate 83%
- African American Reduction Drop-Out Target 11%
- African American A-G Completion Rate 32%

**Actions/Services:**

- Develop College & Career Readiness Indicators 5Cs – Graduate Profile
- Develop rubrics to measure the 5Cs
- Define the core counseling services that each student will receive
- Counselors will actively recruit and reenroll non-grads for 5<sup>th</sup> year
- All African American students will have an Individual Learning Plan developed by September 30<sup>th</sup> and updated twice a year
- All African American students will be actively recruited to ensure they attend the Summer Bridge Program
